**Discussion Questions:**

1. Why does Paul choose to title himself as a slave?
2. What does it mean that Paul was an apostle?
3. What are the two purposes of Paul's apostleship according to verse 1? Explain.
4. In your own words, explain the phrase "truth which is according to godliness".
5. Does having right doctrine always translate to right living? Explain.
6. What subtle hint does verse 2 give in how believers can grow in godliness?
7. What is the hope that *truth* offers believers?
8. Considering the context of this letter as a whole, why do you think Paul goes out of his way to note that God does not lie?
9. According to verse 3, how does God reveal to the world the hope of eternal life?
10. Why do you think Paul describes Titus as his child?
11. How does verse 4 point to the deity of Christ? (Hint: consider verse 3)

**Application Questions**

1. In light of the fact that all believers are to be slaves of Christ, what areas of your life do not reflect a slave-like submission to His desires?
2. What practical things could you do in order to increase the input of biblical truth or decrease the amount of worldly deception?
3. Would your co-workers or family members consider you a hypocrite? If so, how should you respond?
